BRILLIANT	6-8'	Southern indica	carmine red	Deep red blooms, blotched purplish red. Dense, spreading.
CALIFORNIA SUNSET		Belgian indica	salmon pink	Single blossoms, salmon pink edged in white.
CORAL BELLS	3'	Kurume	coral pink	Small flowers coral pink shaded darker in centers, small leaves.
CONSTANCE		Rutherfordiana	lavender pink	Large single lavender pink flowers, light green leaves.
DUC DE ROHAN	5-6'	Southern indica	salmon	Single flowers salmon with rose throats; spreading plant.
FLAMINGO RED		Knap Hill (D)	flamingo pink	Huge, frilled flamingo pink flowers on strong plant.
FIELDER'S WHITE		Southern indica	white	Frilled single white flowers lightly blotched with chartreuse.
GEISHA( GIRL)		Glen Dale	white w/pink	White centers striped or bordered in pinks to red.
GEORGE L. TABOR	6-8'	Southern indica	light pink	Large single flowers light pink with darker centers.
GETSUTOKU		Satsuki	white striped w/pink & red	
GLORY OF SUNNINGHILL		Southern indica	orange-red	Vivid orange-red single flowers.
GUMPO PINK	2 1/2'	Satsuki Hyb.	rose pink	Single rose-pink flowers with deeper flecks; low, dense plant.
GUMPO WHITE	2 1/2'	Satsuki Hyb.	white	Large single white flowers; low, dense plant.
HAPPY DAYS		Belgian indica	fuchsia	Deep fuchsia, double; 10 month blooming season.
HEXE		Kurume	crimson red	Crimson red single flowers on fairly low, spreading plant.
HIGASA	2 1/2'	Satsuki Hyb.	rose pink	Huge 4" flat blooms, deep rose with paler margins.
HINO-CRIMSON	3'	Kurume	brilliant red	Small brilliant red single blooms, foliage turns red in winter.
IVERYANA		Southern indica	streaked white	Single flowers. White with orchid streaks.
JUKO	2 1/2'	Satsuki Hyb	lt. orchid pink	Large single, pointed blooms. Petals often speckled deeper rose.
KORYU		Satsuki Hyb.	pale peach	Cream to pale peach blooms, occasional darker stripes.
LINDA		Satsuki	salmon pink	Huge salmon pink, single blooms cover the plant. Compact.
ORANGE CHIMES		Belgian indica	reddish-orange	Deep reddish-orange, semidouble blooms. Upright habit.
ORANGE PRIDE		Southern indica	reddish-orange	Bright reddish-orange flowers.
PHOENICIA/FORMOSA	6-8'	Southern indica	lavender-magenta	Fluorescent large single lavender-magenta flowers. Vigorous.
PINK LACE		Southern indica	purplish-pink	Deep purplish-pink blooms, hose-in-hose.
PRIDE OF DORKING		Southern indica	brilliant red	Brilliant carmine red single flowers; upright, compact plant.
PURITY		Rutherfordiana	pure white	Pure white flowers, single to semi-double, hose-in-hose.
PURPLE SPLENDOR		Gable	red-violet	Frilled red-violet flowers with darker blotch, single hose-in-hose.
RED RUFFLES	3-6'	Rutherfordiana	strong red	Deep, strong red, hose-in-hose, ruffled
RED BIRD/RED WING		Belgian indica	deep purplish red	Single flowers, hose-in-hose, late bloom
ROSEBUD		Gable hybrids	pink	Blooms heavily in mid-season

SHERWOOD ORCHID		Kurume	orchid-lavender	Large single blooms, orchid-lavender with darker blotches.
SHERWOOD RED		Kurume	orange-red	Brilliant orange red single flowers.
SHINNYO-NO-TSUKI		Satsuki	violet-red	Large single flowers, violet red with white centers.
SOUTHERN CHARM	6-8'	Southern indica	watermelon-pink	Large single watermelon-pink blooms. Large leaves, open habit.
WARD'S RUBY		Kurume	dark red	Brilliant dark-red small, single blooms. Low, spreading plant.
WHITE APRIL		Southern indica	white	Large single white flowers; upright growth.
YOSHINO		Kurume	deep reddish-orange	Blooms early to mid-season, single flowers
WHITE LACE		Southern Indica	white	Large single white flowers. Filtered sun.

**Belgian Indica**--Originally developed for greenhouse forcing, many of them serve well as landscape plants. They have lush, full foliage and profuse large blossoms. Can tolerate temperatures down to 20 degrees.

**Gable Hybrids**--Developed to produce Kurume-type that can take zero degree temperature.

**Glenn Dale Hybrids**--Bred for hardiness but have some leaf drop in cold winter.

**Kurume**--Compact, twiggy plants, dense foliage with small leaves. Profuse bloom.

**Rutherfordiana**--Greenhouse plant, best in gardens where temperature does not drop below 20 degrees. Bushy 2-4' plants with handsome foliage. Flowers between Kurume and Belgian Indica.

**Satsuki**--Low, mounding to 2'x3'. Large blooms late, often in June. Hardy to 5 degrees.

**Southern Indica**--Varieties selected from Belgian Indicas for sun tolerance and vigor. Most take temperatures down to 10 degrees, but some damaged at 20 degrees. Faster growing, more vigorous, and taller than other hybrids--between 5-8'.
